# THE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION CHECKLIST

## General information about scholarships and awards:

- Each scholarship has specific requirements. Please read *Scholarship Descriptions* and *Scholarship Requirements* for details.
- Recipients are selected without regard to race, sex, color, ethnic origin, religious belief, marital status or physical handicap.
- Recipients are expected to maintain good academic standing and meet specific scholarship criteria throughout the award period. Upon request, recipients will provide confirmation of such to Foundation staff.
- Scholarship funds will be paid from the Washington Wine Industry Foundation to the educational institution which the student is or will be attending.
- Payment of funds requires enrollment in the major or accepted area in the college or university stated in student's application.
- All application materials must be received by our office on or before **May 31, 2021** or your application will not be considered. Scholarship awardees will be notified in July.

## All scholarship applicants must submit:

- Master Scholarship Application – *one per applicant regardless of scholarships applied for*
- Personal Essay
- Upcoming Year Coursework Plan
- Two (2) Sealed Letters of Recommendation
- Media Information Form and Photo
- Official Sealed School Transcripts

## Graduate Student Applicants ONLY:

- Graduate Student Expenses

## OPTIONAL:

- Statement of Financial Need including completed FAFSA4carter form  
Horse Heaven Hills Wine Growers Scholarship Applicants ONLY:
- Letter from Parent's Employer

**Completed applications must be received by our office on or before 5pm PST Monday, May 31, 2021. Late applications will NOT be accepted.**
